- 1. How your health information will be used: Your health information will be used by your Provider to:
 - Provide you with medical treatment and related services
 - Coordinate your medical care with other healthcare providers
 - Improve the quality of medical care you receive
- 2. What types of information about you are included:
 - Your health information may include a history of illnesses or injuries you have had, test results, and lists of medications you have taken.
 - Sensitive health conditions may also be included such as:

- 5. **Penalties for improper use or access of your health information:** There are penalties for wrongful access to or use of your health information through CommonWell HIE. If at any time you suspect that someone who should not have seen or gotten access to your health information has done so, contact the Provider listed on this form at (904) 513-3179.
- 6. **Re-disclosure of information:** Health information about you may be re-disclosed by the Provider to others only to the extent permitted by state and federal laws and regulations. Pham Cardiovascular Center and healthcare providers who access this information through CommonWell HIE must comply with these regulations.
- 7. **Effective period**: This Consent Form will remain in effect for this episode of your medical care.
- 8. **Withdrawing your consent:** You may withdraw your consent at any time by signing a new Consent Form. Providers that have accessed your health information through CommonWell while your consent was in effect may copy or include your health information in their own medical records. If you decide to withdraw your consent, those providers are not required to return or remove your health information from their records.
